Any organization or member of the public is encouraged to nominate a candidate, provided the nomination is routed through one of the aforementioned organizations.

The nomination deadlines for 2026 are as follows:

- May 1, 2025: Deadline to approach a member or associate member organization regarding a nomination for induction.
- May 30, 2025: Deadline for submission of nomination materials to a member or associate member organization for review.

Nomination packages must adhere to the outlined criteria and should not exceed six pages, in addition to the Nominator Letter (maximum two pages). Each nomination must also be supported by a minimum of five and a maximum of 10 letters of endorsement.

The 2026 inductees will join the esteemed roster of over 200 individuals who have been inducted into the Canadian Mining Hall of Fame since its establishment in 1989. Those selected for induction in 2026 will enter the Canadian Mining Hall of Fame on January 8, 2026.
